



Important notice to our customers:

Target stores announced on December 19, 2013, that shoppers who used their credit or debit cards to shop at Target between November 27 and December 15, 2013, may be among the 40 million whose card information was subject to security fraud.

If you shopped at Target during this period, here are some things you can do:

- Monitor your credit card account online
- Utilize Online Banking to monitor activity on your debit card
- Set up e-alerts
- Contact your bank or credit card company immediately if you suspect any fraudulent behavior on your accounts.
- Consider cancelling the account used, or asking for a new card to be issued.

Target advised customers Thursday to check their statements carefully. Those who see suspicious charges should report them to their credit card companies and call Target at 866-852-8680.
